Dear Parents,

Tomorrow, February 5, is the close of our Catholic Schools Week. Our closing Mass will begin at 10:30 a.m. in Holy Rosary Church. Kindergarten through fourth grade students will be bussed to the New Holstein campus at 10:10 a.m. for the closing CSW Mass, lunch and Talent Show. Only the Kiel K – 8 students will ride the shuttle bus back to the Kiel campus for dismissal **if they are not going home with their Special Person/Guest after the Talent Show**. Before the closing Mass the K – 4 students will drop off their backpacks or coats in the school. All students will proceed through the gym to church. Special Persons may meet their student in the gym in order to sit with them at Mass if they so choose.

## Special Person's Lunch

Lunch will begin immediately after the closing CSW Mass in the gym/cafeteria (approximately 11:45). About 200 people have RSVP'd for lunch. Because of limited seating, lunch will be served in two shifts. **Students with a LAST NAME beginning with the letters M to Z will eat lunch with their special person first. As people finish their lunch and dispose of their table settings, the "second shift" (students with a LAST NAME beginning with the letters A to L) will be called to lunch over the PA system (approximately 12:15 p.m.)**. Students are reminded that they are to remain with their Special Person during the lunch period by visiting with them and/or giving them a tour of the building/classrooms. Please remember that the teachers are not on supervisory duty at lunchtime. They will be enjoying their own lunch.

## Talent Show

The Talent show will begin around 12:45 p.m. after lunch. An announcement will be made over the PA system calling all to the gym for the show. Students should sit with their Special Person during the show unless they are in the show. Students performing with their entire class in an act will be called to the back of the gym a few acts before theirs in order to get organized with their teacher for their performance. Individuals/small groups with an act will have a section of the bleachers to the left of the stage reserved for them as a "staging area" before their performance. After performing, students can rejoin their Special Person. We have over 30 acts for the Talent Show. With a starting time of approximately 12:45 p.m. the show should end about 2:15 p.m. if all goes as planned. But in show biz...you never know!

## Dismissal

Students are dismissed for the day after the Talent Show with their Special Person. Students NOT leaving with their Special Person should remain with their teacher to either return by shuttle (Kiel students only) or wait for the New Holstein bus (to take them home in the usual fashion.) Parents, if dismissal plans have changed, please notify the NH school office.

### **Kindergarten Screening**

Kindergarten Screening for children whose parents plan on enrolling them at Divine Savior for the 2010-2011 school year will be held February 18. Parents should contact the Kiel campus school office to schedule a screening time and date. Screening takes approximately an hour. The Kindergarten Diagnostic Instrument (KDI) will be used to evaluate each child's readiness to enter kindergarten in the Fall. Children must be 5 years old by September 1, 2010 to attend Kindergarten. Current Divine Savior 4 year old students will be screened during their morning sessions the week of February 15.
