



Pie Fundraiser Update

Welcome to a new year of apple pie making! This year we are excited to announce that we are going to make **5,000** apple pies! The fundraising committee is looking forward to working with all the school families to reach this goal.

August 30th (orientation/registration day) is when you will be able to sign up for shifts to produce the pies. All families are asked to sign up for five (5) shifts (see below for specific shift times).

Assembly of the pies includes preparing apples (peeling and coring), inspection of apple wedges, mixing and filling pie shells, topping, boxing and bagging the finished pie. The only portion of the pie that is not made by the school is the crust.

Students in grades 6th-8th are welcome to help with childcare after school hours and on Saturday (this would be great for service hours).
