A NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

Registration at Divine Savior Catholic School for the 2020-2021 school year will begin in February for CHOICE families and March for all others. New this year will be on-line registration utilizing FACTS Management. This company will also be handling the tuition collection and financial assistance.

Among our goals for the upcoming school year and beyond is to improve the way students and their families apply for admission and then complete enrollment at Divine Savior School. Many parents have desired to complete the process online. This format will eliminate excessive paperwork, clean up inaccuracies in our data, easily track the admission process from beginning to end, and reduce the amount of duplicate data entry that occurs in our office. With the financial aspect, you will have the ability for payments to be paid directly online. Details will be presented at a parent meeting scheduled for February 25 at 6:00 in Volland Hall. The registration process will open on-line on March 2. We are working with the company to make sure the process goes smoothly before opening the registration. More information to access the FACTS site will be announced later in February.

Divine Savior School continues to participate in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program. Students entering 4K, 5K, grade 1 or anyone new to Divine Savior School is eligible. Qualifying families do not pay any tuition or fees. In addition to completing the FACTS Management registration process, families that qualify for the CHOICE program must register on-line with the Department of Public Instruction (DPI). (Students currently in the CHOICE program do not need to meet the income requirements BUT must register annually with the DPI.) The window to register is February 3 – April 16. The application is available at <https://dpi.wi.gov/sms/choice-programs/student-applications>. FAMILIES APPLYING FOR THE CHOICE PROGRAM SHOULD COMPLETE THE DPI APPLICATION AS SOON AS POSSIBLE and then complete the Divine Savior paperwork online after March 2.

Divine Savior School is also a member of the Special Needs Scholarship Program. This program provides students with speech services, occupational therapy, and tutoring services. To qualify for this program, a student needs to have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) developed by the public school. There are no income level requirements for this program and enrollment in this program may be done at any time.

If you have any questions, please contact the school office at 894-3533. Parents that are new to the CHOICE program should call the school office BEFORE completing the on-line DPI application.
