## A NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

The Green Bay Diocese is currently developing lists of items to address when re-opening school for the 2020-2021 school year. All diocesan schools are expected to open as planned. For us that would be September 1.

September 1 is still too distant to make a complete list of final decisions. Some things we have prepared, and other items are under consideration. What we have done so far or considered is:

- We have purchased a disinfecting machine that will be used daily along with the regular cleaning.
- Hand sanitizer stations are being placed in every classroom.
- Temperature scanners have been purchased for use in checking everyone who enters the building.
- Sharing of supplies such as pencils, marker, scissors, etc. will not be allowed. **We are asking every student to have a soft pencil pouch to carry these types of supplies with them.**
- Families will be required to notify the school if any family member has contracted the virus.
- Students must have individual water bottles. The bubblers will not be used.
- We have scheduled two lunch sessions to allow us to spread out students during mealtime.

There are numerous other items to consider. I would like to have a PLANNING GROUP FOR THE RE-OPENING that would consist of some parents, board members, and teachers.
