If you have been hearing discussions about the start-up again in Fall and what might be expected, please know that these are rumors and talking points. There are no finalized plans in place for what school may look like come September 1. I will email you the specifics as soon as they are finalized. Both the diocese and public schools are working on a coherent and practical plan.

The teachers will be meeting this summer to discuss what virtual learning would look like in the event we need to do this again sometime in the future. Your input would be very valuable. If you would like to share your insights and thoughts, please send me an email. I would specifically like to know what went well and what did not. Is there anything your child's teacher(s) could have done differently? Was there anything the teachers specifically did that helped you and your child get through this unique learning experience? I hope we never have to teach like this again, but we need to prepare in the event we would be in a similar situation.

There will be a few staff changes for next school year. We welcome Mrs. Gozdziwski back to Divine Savior School. She will be teaching reading and language to grades 3-4-5. She will also be teaching some of the phy. ed. classes. Mrs. Binversie will be teaching 4K (mornings) next school year as well as Spanish classes and Miss April will be teaching 4K and literacy in the afternoon. The rest of the staff is returning. I am presently looking for a music teacher as the situation with the conservatory and Holy Family College is very unsettled.

On Wednesday, Fr. Carl, Mr. Zenk, and the teachers will gather in Church to celebrate a closing liturgy for the school year. You will be sent the link for you and your child(ren) to view. We hope this celebration of faith is a fitting close to our school year.
