# Violin Group Classes

## QUICK FACTS:

- Group Classes start using mock violins provided by the teacher - You do not need a violin to begin!
- After 2-3 weeks of classes each student should buy or rent a violin (the teacher will advise about sizing and rates)
- Registration for each session of 6 Group Classes costs \$60.00
- No need to sign up for the whole year at once - there will be 5 sessions built into the school year calendar and you can decide about renewing your registration with each new session.
- Group classes last 45 minutes and take place during the school day once per week
- Students will have at least 2 opportunities to perform each year as a group and as soloists
