A NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

After months of planning for the re-opening of school, that day is finally upon us. We look forward to gathering once again next Tuesday. A few reminders:

Doors open at 7:30. Students should be dropped off on the school side of Fifth Street and enter the gym doors. Late buses or tardy students (7:50) will need to enter using the breezeway entrance as in the past.

Auto pick-up of students will be the same. A teacher will bring students to the parking lot.

The New Holstein shuttle bus will run as normal. However, Kiel will not shuttle students to the elementary school as in the past so that students are only using one bus. All Kiel buses will come to Divine Savior and students will board their respective buses. (I believe students will not be allowed to get a pass to ride a bus to a friend's house as in the past.)

If your child rides the bus but will not be in school due to illness or their busing arrangement needs to be changed, please contact Divine Savior School, AND the bus company. The bus company phone number is 898-4207. The Kiel number is no longer valid. All calls must go to the 898-4207 phone number.

If you are in the Kiel School District and your child typically rides the bus, but is not going to ride the bus at the start of the school year, please send an email with you/your child's name to Sheila Lefeber (sklefeber@kiel.k12.wi.us) to let her know that your child/ren will not be riding; this will help to contact trace more efficiently. Also notify the bus company.

If your child had been using the shuttle bus to transport to and from Divine Savior School to the elementary school, be advised that the shuttle bus will not be used, at least initially.

Parents and visitors will not be allowed into school for the time being. The only exception is for new students and 4K students whose parents may enter the building with them at 7:15. By 7:30 all parents in the building will need to leave.

All staff, students, and visitors must wear face masks in the building. The teachers will allow for mask breaks by taking students outside or having a break as needed for that purpose.

All classrooms are now air conditioned which will make wearing masks easier.

The hot lunch menu is also attached to this newsletter. Until the covid situation changes, we will serve one menu each day. Every student will receive every item listed in the menu. They do not need to eat everything on the tray. Trays and milk will be delivered to the students at their tables by the teachers. Students taking morning milk will have the milk cost deducted daily from their lunch/milk account. You will no longer need to pay for the semester or the entire year. Please contact Amy if you have questions about the prepaid account for lunch/milk.

As stated in previous newsletters, water bottles are needed for ALL students. The "clear" policy is being waived to allow for greater options for those water bottles. For liturgies on Tuesdays (beginning with the first one on Sept. 8), students do not need to wear church clothing. We cannot have children change clothes so the clothing normally worn will be acceptable.

In Church, students will be assigned pews to socially distance and they will sit with siblings.

At staff meetings this week, the teachers will be working out plans to maintain social distancing as much as possible. This will include classrooms, rest rooms, and the hallway.

As situations change, we will keep you informed. Please contact your child's teachers or the school office if you have any questions or concerns. We are hopefully everything goes well.

I was not in school last week and will be out this week as well. My son contacted covid and as a result I am in quarantine. I will be able to return to school on September 1.
