Dear Parents,

We are still seeking volunteers to spend time in the office while Amy is out with her knee surgery. She will be out on February 23 and then for about six weeks beginning March 13. Amy will be working from home during this time so you would mainly be answering the phone and monitoring people coming in and out of the school. If you are able to help in the office any day of the week, morning, or afternoon, please send an email to the school office so we can make a schedule. Your assistance is greatly appreciated.

Lent begins next week Wednesday with Ash Wednesday. Students in grades 3-8 will attend Mass at 8:00 and students in grades 4K-2 will attend a prayer service led by Mr. Zenk at 11:00. Due to the pandemic, ashes will not be marked on the foreheads as in past years. Instead, students will have the option to come forward and have ashes sprinkled on their hair. **THIS IS AN OPTION.** Please discuss this with your child.

We will also be participating in the parishes' almsgiving project called REACHING OUT IN EASTER JOY. The goal is to collect money for gift baskets for the community nursing homes and assisted living facilities and parishioners in such facilities in neighboring communities. Students will be encouraged to bring in coins to add to a classroom egg that will be presented during the Tuesday liturgies during Lent.

The Stations of the Cross will be prayed in Church at 2:00 on February 28 and March 28. The other weeks of Lent they will be prayed in class.

Fr. Carl will hear confessions for selected grades after Mass beginning February 23.
