LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

Best wishes for a happy new year. I pray the bad of 2020 is replaced with an abundance of good in 2021.

The Board of Trustees met in December to begin development of the budget for 2021-2022. A key part of that process is the completion of student registration which will be open on February 1. The board has made a sincere effort to control costs in the operation of the school. Tuition for next year will increase \$25. All other fees will remain the same. More details will be sent home in the following weeks.

Our per pupil cost to provide a Catholic education is approximately \$8730 per student. Of that total, the parishes contribute approximately \$3400 toward your child's education (39%). Fundraising and donations contribute approximately \$3230 toward the total cost (37%). Tuition and fees (registration, technology) are \$2100 (24%). As you can see, with the bulk of the cost being borne by the parishes and our fundraising, it is important to be an active supporter of the parish and to be involved with the fundraisers.

Next year, the \$600 charge for fundraising help will not be added to the initial tuition calculation in FACTS. Rather, if a family did not help with the pie project or the auction, the charge will be added on after the completion of the event and the monthly payment recalculated for the remainder of the school year payments.

Our students are presently engaged in taking the Winter MAP tests. We were not able to administer these tests last Spring or this Fall due to the quarantines so this testing will be very important to assess the level of learning of our students. We should have the test results before the end of the month and they can be discussed at the parent/teacher conferences on February 18.

As far as conferences are concerned, we will again be conducting them virtually as we did in November. If you had any issues or difficulties with the virtual format the first time, please contact us so that we can possibly rectify the problem.

As I indicated in the December 18 newsletter, the Board of Trustees will have a listening session for anyone wishing to speak about the Choice or SNSP program and have any clarification about these programs. This listening session is at 6:15 on Tuesday, January 26. Registration for the Choice program begins the following week. You are also most welcome to contact me for further information.

Now in the winter season, please review the school closure procedures in the family handbook (page 11). As a reminder, if one of the two school districts close and the other remains open, we will close. In the event of a delay, follow the directions of your resident district.
