## MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

The diocesan office has asked that we comply with the CDC guidelines regarding out-of-state travel. Here is the directive:

### GET TESTED BEFORE AND AFTER TRAVEL

- If you are traveling, get tested with a [viral test](#) 1-3 days before your trip. Make sure you have the results of your negative test before you travel. Keep a copy of your results with you during travel; you might be asked for them.
- **Do not travel if you test positive.** Immediately [isolate](#) yourself, and follow [public health recommendations](#).
- Get tested again with a viral test 3-5 days after your trip and stay home and self-quarantine for a full 7 days after travel, even if your test is negative. If you do not get tested, stay home and self-quarantine for 10 days after travel.
- You may have been exposed to COVID-19 on your travels. Regardless of where you traveled or what you did during your trip, take these actions to protect others from getting COVID-19 after travel:
  - Avoid crowds and [stay at least 6 feet/2 meters](#) (about 2 arm lengths) from anyone who did not travel with you. It is important to do this everywhere — both indoors and outdoors. [Wear a mask](#) over your nose and mouth when in public settings. [Masks are required](#) on planes, buses, trains, and other forms of public transportation traveling into, within, or out of the United States and in U.S. transportation hubs such as airports and stations.
  - If there are people in the household who did not travel with you, [wear a mask](#) and ask everyone in the household to wear masks in shared spaces inside your home for 14 days after travel.
  - [Wash your hands](#) often or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
  - Avoid being around people who are at [increased risk for severe illness](#).
  - Watch your health: Look for [symptoms](#) of COVID-19.
