## LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

I have been in contact this week with the county Health Department. This weekend will mark the 10<sup>th</sup> day of quarantine. I was told we can re-open Monday, November 2 which we will do. However, if you feel safer keeping your child home for the full 14 days of quarantine, we respect those wishes. Your child may participate in classes via Google Classroom and return in person on Friday. If that is your intent, please let your child's teacher(s) know or contact the school office and we will relay that information.

Covid-19 has certainly been an extreme challenge for our families, friends, and school community. It is precisely because of these challenges that we must act as a community, people that care for and respect one another. We cannot stress enough how important it is that EVERYONE follow the health department guidelines. They have been constantly stressing social distancing, the avoidance of large group gatherings, face coverings, and frequent hand washing. To disregard these recommendations can only lead to more and longer virtual learning formats.

The staff at Divine Savior has really been hit hard and there hasn't been much of a connection among the positive cases. Over half of the staff have had covid-19 or have been in quarantine.

I hope you realize that the school staff is doing all we can to promote the safety and welfare of your child(ren). All our decisions are based upon that concern. Thank you for your support as we are forced to make some tough decisions. And thank you for all your efforts to minimize the spread of the virus.

When classes resume Monday, students in grades 1-8 are welcome to wear Halloween costumes. Costumes may not be distracting, must comply with the dress code, and may not have weapons. Shoes must be worn as part of the school dress code. If children bring treats to share, remember they must be a commercially pre-packaged, individually wrapped item.

**BAND STUDENTS:** Miss Wasmer and Mr. Burk will be adding more band lessons **beginning next week**. Band students should bring their instruments Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays.

This week you should have received the invitation from Sign-Up Genius to register for a parent-teacher conference on November 24. If you did not receive that invitation, please let me know as soon as possible. Our music teacher Mrs. Clements, our band instructors, and I were not included in the sign-up. If you wish to talk to any of us, please let me know and we will make arrangements with you.

On Monday, the Church celebrates the Feast of All Souls. The school has a Book of Remembrance in which students have placed memorials for loved ones. If your family has lost someone special this past year, please have your child take a paper, complete it, and add it to this Book of Remembrance. We occasionally include these names of loved ones in a special prayer service.
