## LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

Covid-19 continues to affect the staff. We now have had four positive tests and four who had been or are now in quarantine. Two positive cases had previously been in quarantine. I can't adequately express how hard the staff has worked and continues to work to make things run as smoothly as possible and to cover for one another's duties. We have also been very fortunate that so many parents and grandparents have stepped forward. I have hired some additional aides that will help us also. We welcome Laure Grube, Peggy Danes, and Michelle Schneider to our staff.

Parents have been scheduled for the office on Monday and Tuesday. If Amy is still not able to return, I will contact volunteers for Wednesday and Thursday.

With the continued severity of the pandemic, I would ask that you please continue to mask, stress social distancing, and frequent handwashing. AND please do not send your child to school if he/she is showing any symptoms or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive.

Due to the large increase in cases, the county health department is no longer able to contact trace when a positive test occurs. It is very important therefore that you notify the school if there is any testing, exposure, or symptoms being shown in your family or contacts. If any classmate or staff meet the quarantine criteria as a result, we will contact you.

Mackenzie Bonde will cook for us next Monday and Tuesday. Depending upon when Megan can return to the kitchen, Wednesday and Thursday may be cold lunch days. We will let you know next week.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate this difficult time. Amy and I have been working from home throughout our quarantine and illness but there are some things that are just delayed because we are not physically present in school. If you are having any issues with FACTS (tuition, lunch, and day care payments) know that Amy will attend to these issues as soon as she gets back to school.

**I just wanted to draw your attention to the school calendar. Friday is an in-service day so classes will not be in session. The Kiel Public Schools are also dismissing early on Thursday. WE ARE NOT and special busing will be provided at the usual times.**

Thank you to everyone who helped make the Apple Pie fundraiser a success despite the current situation and the limitations it placed on the activity.
